## SO HOW DO I RECYCLE?

**Paper:** Recycle white (white copier paper, letter head, notebook paper, etc.) and mixed paper (envelopes, index cards, newspaper, etc.—no wax-coated milk cartons) in the bins outside your dorm.

**Aluminum, Glass, Steel, and All #s Plastic:** Recycle these materials (we accept plastic bags but NO Styrofoam) in the bins outside your dorm. Please remove the caps (which are made of non-recyclable plastic), empty containers, and rinse them out if possible.

**Cardboard:** Cardboard should be emptied, broken down, and placed next to the trash and recycling containers outside.

**Electronics:** Drop off CDs, DVDs, Jewel Cases, Floppy Disks, VHS tapes, cell phones, and used ink cartridges at the E-cycling box on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Newcomb outside the Game Room by the computers.

**Reusable Items:** Office supplies can be donated to the Reusable Office Supply Exchange (R.O.S.E.) at UVA Recycling's office at the end of Leake Drive off Alderman. At the end of each semester, you can donate anything from non-perishable food to furniture to our "Chuck it for Charity" Program.
