Conserving Paper



Reduce:

- Print double-sided
 - At your home computer, print half your document, flip the printed pages over and put them back in the printer, and print the rest.
 - Choose the double-sided option with capable printers.
- Use electronic Post-its! Go here to find out more:

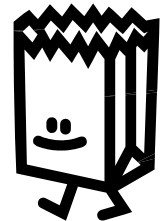

- Use whiteboards for messages instead of notepads.
- Use your own hand towel instead of paper towels when you use the bathroom.
- Take notes on your laptop instead of paper.

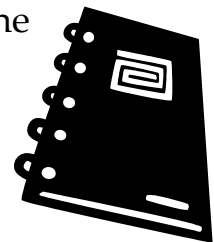
Reuse:

- Reuse notebooks: after a class is over, tear out the pages used and use the rest of the notebook next semester!
- Reuse paper bags from the grocery store for storage, packing material, or as trashbags.



Recycle:

- Recycle all the paper you use! Don't forget: newspapers, packaging materials, old class materials, boxes from food (like cereal boxes), paper towel roll inserts, etc!
- Buy recycled paper. From recycled notebooks (which are in the bookstore) to recycled paper towels, you can easily complete the recycling cycle!
